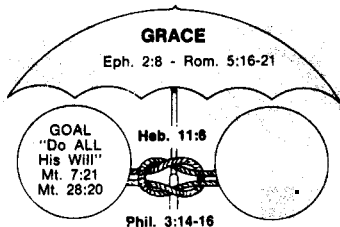


**15. Review** (See OBS Worksheet — Cross)

**1. Acts 20:7**
